The Bridge runs two weekly youth groups; one for those aged 11 - 16 and one for those aged 17 - 25. These groups provide a safe and social space to meet other LGBTQ young people, get support and enjoy activities, trips and workshops about the things that matter to you.

This service also includes:

- One-to-one advice and support sessions for LGBTQ young people aged 11 25
- Free training sessions for professionals to help them develop their knowledge and confidence to support LGBTQ young people in Croydon
